^X FAC Rubber Scale #2 will be THREE FLIGHT AVERAGE and we will use use INVERTED TIME FACTORING.

2019 NON-NATS NEWS

Hi Skysters! Remember last year, when we asked you to pre-register your models online, after registering yourself for the meet? We're doing it again!! It's EASY!

PLEASE PRE-REGISTER YOUR MODELS ONLINE PRIOR TO THE MEET!

- 1) First, register for the contest by mail, in the way you always have.
- 2) Second, you'll receive an e-mail confirmation from Rick Pendzick. This will include your **Contest Registration #** and copies of your **2015-2018 Pilot's Reports**. The e-mail will also include a link to an online "**Add Model**" form.
- 3) On the online Add Model Form, you enter your Contest Registration #, and use the information on your Pilot's Reports to pre-register ALL the models you intend to fly at the meet. **You will be sent an automatic confirmation of each pre-registered model, via e-mail.**
- 4) When you have entered ALL your models, there will be a button on the online form that says "Finished-All Models Added". Click that button, and you will be e-mailed customized *Time Sheets*, with all your models filled in for you. Pretty neat, huh? **Print your timesheets out, and bring them to the meet!**
- 5) Use the customized Time Sheets to record your flight times. Bring them to GHQ periodically during the day so we can input your times. **Remember to hand them in to GHQ at the end of each day so that we can double check the scores overnight.** Pick them back up in the morning and you're ready to go.

NOTE! If you are unable to register your models online, prepare a list of the models you intend to fly and present it to GHQ on Registration Day, Wednesday July 17th. We will work with you to input your models and print out your time sheets on the spot. However....if at all possible.....

PLEASE TAKE ADVANTAGE OF THE ONLINE MODEL PRE-REGISTRATION!! It saves GHQ a LOT of work!!!

BACKGROUND

FAC GHQ has been keeping digital data on all models flown at the Nats / Non Nats since 2015. We know when any given model has been:

- 1) Scale judged, and the scores received, or
- 2) Checked for and passed PPLC compliance, or
- 3) Checked for and passed other rules compliance requirements, such as plan reviews, or
- 4) Awarded bonus points as required, or
- 5) Any combination of the above

Models that were flown at the 2015-2018 Nats / Non Nats can be pre-registered online and flown at the 2019 Non-Nats without any further scale judging or compliance review.

NEW models that have not yet been flown at a Nats / Non Nats should also be pre-registered, but must go through the appropriate Scale Judging / Compliance / Bonus Point Award reviews for the events in which they are entered. Once so judged or reviewed at the 2019 Non-Nats, they can be entered into future Nats / Non Nats without further review.
