A new plastic wrap that's on the market makes a great masking medium for painting your models. It's called <u>Glad Press 'N Seal</u> and it's available in most supermarkets across the country. What's unique about this product is that it's sticky on one side so that it can readily adhere to itself or to the surface of the model you want paint. It's relatively easy to work with, clings to model surfaces quite well, but can be removed without lifting off paint or tearing up tissue covering (of course this assumes you use the necessary care needed for this kind of work - Wingtips Editor)
