

GUILLOW'S NON-SCALE SPORT MODEL RULES - Classic and Modern Era COMBINED

Some of the non-scale early Guillow's Sport "Classic Era" models are listed in the chart below left. We're sure there's many more out there, we just don't know them! These models are long out of production as kits.

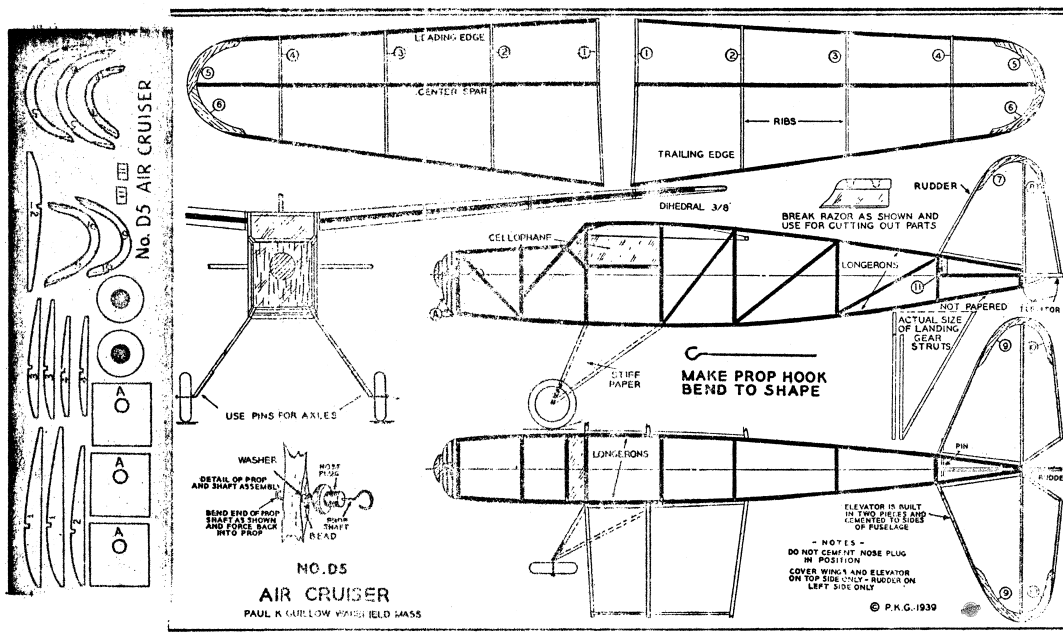
Then there's the non-scale "Modern Era" Guillow's sport models. The models listed in the chart below right are all still in production--the Arrow, The Javelin, The Lancer, and the Fly Boy (apparently, originally a Comet design). Again, there may be many more from the past of which we are unaware.

Whatever the construction method, whatever the era of design, we will fly ALL these non-scale sport models together in the FAC Non Scale class to which they are most suited by configuration. Examples:

- The Javelin could fly in OT Fuselage OR 2-Bit+1.
- The Lancer flies in OT Stick.
- The Fly Boy could fly in OT Fuselage or 2-Bit+1.
- Some of the 8" "D" series models could be scaled up to be Embryo Endurance models.

Y'all ought to be able to figure out what flies where. Puh-LEEEZE, Phineas....don't drag us deep into the slimy weeds of rules and regulations on these birds. Just build one or two, and have fun, willya?

- A. Unless specifically stated otherwise, all normal FAC TOTF non-scale rules apply for non-scale Guillows Classic and Modern Era builds.
- B. At the 2026 FAC Nats, TOTF Non Scale cut-off dates for eligibility are WAVED for all Guillows "Modern Era" Non Scale designs.
- C. Build to the plan! Plan structure may be added to, but not removed.
 1. Sheet structure of "Modern Era" non scale models must be honored.
- D. Plug-in wings and stabs can be reworked to be one piece if desired.
- E. Use any nose button / prop shaft / prop / rubber motor you want. Plastic nose blocks on "modern era" designs can be replaced with balsa.
- F. Guillows non scale sport models compete in the FAC class for which they would normally qualify.
- G. There is no special "Guillows Kanone" for non scale Guillows sport models. Guillows designs will be recognized, but models will be scored as normal FAC entries.
